**Abstract:** AMPCO’s presentation to member companies of its 2012 Q3 power market outlook. Along with the market outlook will be a comprehensive forecast of delivered prices for power in Ontario, including price and the Global adjustment. Additional analysis of demand response during peak periods and some comparative analysis of delivery costs for typical customers served by local distribution companies in Ontario will be discussed.

**Biography:** As President of the Association of Major Power Consumers in Ontario, Mr. White represents business consumers in the forestry, chemical, mining and minerals, steel, petroleum products, cement, automotive and manufacturing industries with operations in Ontario.
